Delivery

We understand that a quick delivery is important on this type of furniture. Even though each item is handmade just for you we strive to deliver within 15 to 20 working days in the UK, and up to 25 days in the Republic of Ireland. Leather furniture takes a little longer to make so please allow an extra 5 working days on leather items. Please note that at busy times and holidays delivery may be a little longer. **Care Instructions**

Upholstery

The manufacturing process in making upholstered furniture involves a great deal of hand finishing therefore you can reasonably expect slight differences in the tailoring and tolerance of each item.

Cushions (Foam Seats & Fibre Backs)

All foam filled cushions will soften within the first few months of use. This is a reaction to normal use and is not a fault. Where possible if your furniture has loose seat cushions we recommend you turn the cushions every couple of days, this will help the cushions hold their shape and will give the cushions a longer lifespan. Most of our Rise Recliner furniture have fixed seat cushions, but they are designed not to be turned. Fibre filled back cushions are normally used on upholstered furniture where a softer more comfortable feel is required. It is guite common for fibre back cushion interiors inside the cushion case to slide around (known as cushion slippage) in some cases this can make the cushion look unsightly. On most of our furniture the back cushions are zipped on, and as such this helps to keep the cushions in place. We still recommend that you plump up the cushions on a regular basis, as this will keep your furniture looking good and extend its lifespan.

Fabric and Leather Characteristics & Care

Chenille & Velvet upholstery fabrics have a softness and lustre. This is created by the thick short erect pile threads on the surface of the fabric and is subject to random crushing and pile pressure, especially on seat cushions. Pile pressure is not a fault and is a characteristic of pile fabrics. It is possible to remove some crush marks by regular brushing or steaming. We recommend that you lightly vacuum your furniture once a week with a soft brush attachment. Please pay close attention to arm fronts where your hands rest as this is one of the main areas for soiling. We recommend that you think about purchasing arm caps for your furniture as this should stop the soiling and give your furniture a longer life. To keep your furniture in the best condition we recommend that you use a professional cleaning service if the furniture has been soiled. Direct sunlight can cause fading, and artificial ageing. We recommend that you protect your furniture where possible by closing curtains or blinds on sunny days.

Leather is a natural product, and a characteristic of leather is that it can stretch and crease with use. With some leathers if you are on certain types of medications the chemicals in the medication can pass through the pores in your skin and affect the leather. This happens mainly through the palms of your hands when you sweat and mainly affects the arm fronts on the furniture. We recommend that you lightly vacuum your furniture once a week with a soft brush attachment, and dust with a soft cloth. If you spill anything on to the leather we recommend that you wipe it with a damp cloth straight away. We advise that you keep your furniture away from radiators, direct sunlight, and other heat sources as it can dry out the leather and cause it to discolour.

<u>Use of your furniture</u>

Please allow adequate space for your furniture to recline fully, as collisions with objects or walls will damage your furniture and could invalidate your guarantee. Look out for items with sharp metal points or sharp edges, buckles, studs, toys or metal buttons on jeans, as all of these can cause damage to the fabric or leather on your furniture. We recommend you keep all animals off your furniture as dogs and cats can cause more damage in a short period of time than you can in years of normal use. Please avoid sitting on arms and the front edge of the seat cushions as this can shorten the lifespan of your furniture.

Electrical

Always remember not to leave your Phone or Tablet on charge and unattended overnight.




